Individuals who submit late or incomplete applications will need to apply during the financial aid open season for the 2018-2019 academic year.

I. PROGRAM MISSION

The mission of the First Baptist Church of Glenarden (FBCG) financial assistance program is to provide financial assistance awards to aid students in the attainment of their educational goals.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following is the criteria for applying for FBCG financial assistance.

Must have financial need.

- Must be a member of First Baptist Church of Glenarden.
- Must be an active and current member of a FBCG Ministry during the 2016-2017 school year.
- Must be working toward an undergraduate degree or professional certification.
- Must be either a graduating high school student or a returning college student.
- Must be a full-time student.
- Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of <u>2.5</u> or higher.
- Age limit is 22 years old at the time of application submission deadline.

III. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The financial assistance application must be completed in order to apply. Financial assistance awards will be granted based upon a point system, with points awarded in four categories. The categories are:

- Financial Need maximum of 40 points
- Church and Christian Outreach Service/Activities maximum of 30 points
- Grade Point Average maximum of 20 points
- Extracurricular Activities/Part-Time Jobs maximum of 10 points

Note: Regardless of the total number of points earned, points <u>must</u> be earned in the categories of Financial Need and Church and Christian Outreach Activities.

The following is an explanation of the four evaluation categories:

1. Financial Need

The information provided on the financial assistance application will be kept confidential. Applicants may be asked to provide proof of household income before they can be considered for need-based financial aid. Do not provide any personal financial documents with this application. Points will be awarded based on financial need using the following criteria:

- Household income of under \$50,000 annually
- Single-parent household
- Household income of \$50,000 \$75,000
- Household income of over \$75,000 \$125,000
- Household income of over \$125,000

2. Church and Christian Outreach Activities - Ministry Involvement

This includes active membership in a FBCG ministry. Active membership indicates participation and volunteerism or service provided to the church community. This also includes any church or college chapel activity by students who may attend school out of the local area. The ministry head must verify all information in writing by filling out the ministry verification form. All memberships/participation must have occurred during the current academic year. You may include up to two activities. (See verification forms for completion of this section.)

Examples that do not qualify are activities in which you are being served, i.e. receiving tutoring services. Thus, if you are in leadership, provide the tutoring services, help with Hospitality or AV, you are an active member of a ministry. All ministry/service must be verified by the ministry leader/supervisor.

3. Grade Point Average

Points will be awarded for Fall 2016 / 1st semester transcript with a point average based on the following criteria:

- 3.8 4.0
- 3.5 3.79
- 3.0 3.49
- 2.5-2.99

An official transcript for courses completed Fall 2016 (college applicants) and as of the end of the second grading period (high school applicants) must be submitted with application by May 1, 2017. Note - The <u>final</u> official transcript for courses completed Spring 2017 must be submitted by June 20, 2017.

4. Extracurricular Activities

Extracurricular activities include membership in school-sponsored clubs/events, sports, part-time jobs, community service projects, etc. These must be current and verified in writing by the sponsor or coordinator; and must have occurred during the <u>current academic year</u>. You may include up to two activities. (See verification form for completion of this section.)

IV. QUALIFICATION/EVALUATION FOR AWARD

- A minimum of 55 points are needed to qualify.
- Applicant must be an undergraduate working toward a degree or professional certification.

V. APPLICATION PROCESS

The financial assistance application process is as follows:

- Complete a FBCG financial assistance form (included in this package).
- Complete a signed Notification Form (included in this package).
- Submit the completed and signed financial assistance form to the Education Ministry with ALL required attachments by the deadline.
- The financial assistance form and notification form must be fully completed and signed by both the student and the parent/guardian.
- FBCG Financial Assistance Committee notifies applicants that a complete or incomplete application was received.

- FBCG Financial Assistance Committee evaluates and recommends recipients.
- Recipients are notified of the initial status of their application by June 1, 2017.
- <u>Cumulative/Final Grade Reports are due by June 20, 2017. (Awards are not confirmed until received.)</u>
- Recipients attend the Annual Financial Assistance Program/ Recognition Sunday in July.
- Lump-sum award checks are disbursed to the recipients' schools electronically in late August.

VI. AVAILABILITY AND PRESENTATION OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARDS

- The number and amount of awards will be based on the funds available.
- Recipients will be recognized on Recognition Sunday. All recipients will be responsible for attending a required service to be recognized.
- Merit awards will be given to first-time students who meet the criteria. <u>All</u> awards will first be based on financial need.

VII. <u>DISQUALIFICATION/FORFEITURE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARD</u>

The following actions will result in the forfeiture/revocation of any financial assistance award:

- Willfully giving false information
- Failure to supply ALL required documentation
- Misuse of funds (Any funds not used for designated purpose MUST be returned to FBCG; funds may be used for the purchase of books if the financial need has been met.)
- Failure to enroll as a full-time student
