I. PROGRAM MISSION

The mission of the First Baptist Church of Glenarden International (FBCG) financial assistance program is to minister to the needs of students and parents by providing financial assistance awards that help students in the attainment of their educational goals.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following is the criteria for applying for FBCG financial assistance.

Current High School Students

- Must have financial need.
- Must be a member of First Baptist Church of Glenarden.
- Must be an active and current member of a FBCG Ministry during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Must be a graduating **college-bound** high school student.
- Must be enrolled full-time in high school.
- Must have a **minimum cumulative grade point average** of **2.5** or higher.
- 23 years old or under at the time of application submission deadline.

Current College Students

- Must have financial need.
- Must be a member of First Baptist Church of Glenarden.
- Must be an active and current member of a campus-based Christian ministry, Christian Ministry Outreach Activity, or a FBCG Ministry during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Must be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate degree program in a university, college, or community college (12 or more credit hours per semester).
- Must have a **minimum cumulative grade point average** of **2.5** or higher.
- 23 years old or under at the time of application submission deadline.

III.EVALUATION CRITERIA

The information provided on the financial assistance application will be kept confidential. The financial assistance application must be completed in order to apply. Financial assistance awards will be granted based upon a point system, with points awarded in four categories. The categories are:

- Financial Need
- Church Ministry Involvement/Christian Outreach Service/Activities
- Cumulative Grade Point Average
- Extracurricular Activities/Part-Time Jobs

Note: Regardless of the total number of points received, points <u>must</u> be earned in the categories of Financial Need and Church Ministry Involvement/Christian Outreach Service/Activities. If applicants do not meet the criteria for financial need and Church Ministry Involvement/ Christian Outreach Activities, an award <u>will not</u> be provided.

The following is an explanation of the four evaluation categories

1. Financial Need

The financial need scoring will be based upon the Student Aid Index (SAI) found under the Eligibility Overview tab of your online Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Submission Summary. If your FAFSA is complete and fully processed by the United States Department of Education, your SAI can be viewed and printed online. **Please attach a copy of the page that provides your 2025-2026 SAI to your FBCG Financial Assistance application.** If you need instructions for obtaining a printed copy of your 2025-2026 SAI, please visit https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/review-and-correct/fafsa-submission-summary#information-contained Please do not provide any other personal financial documents with this application.

2. Church Ministry Involvement and Christian Outreach Activities – Ministry Involvement

Ministry Involvement will be evaluated based upon your active service to others through a FBCG ministry (high school applicants), campus based ministry (college applicants), or Christian outreach activities (college applicants). Participation in social groups, organizations, or non-Christian based groups that provide service to the community will not be accepted. Active membership indicates participation and volunteerism or service provided to the church community. This also includes any church or college chapel activity by students who may attend school out of the local area. The **ministry head** must verify all information in writing by filling out the ministry verification form. All membership(s)/participation must have occurred during the <u>current academic year</u>. You may submit up to two Ministry Involvement Verification forms. The signed Ministry Involvement verification form(s) must be submitted by the application due date for consideration (See verification forms for completion of this section.)

Ministry activities in which: you are being served such as receiving tutoring services, being mentored, etc.; your participation is for a single event, or your participation is only during school breaks (i.e., summer, winter, spring) do not meet this requirement. If you are an active member of a ministry where you are serving others throughout the 2024-2025 academic school year, then this service is applicable to meet this requirement. All ministry/service must be verified by the ministry leader/supervisor. You may submit up to two Ministry Involvement Verification forms.

3. Grade Point Average (GPA)

The cumulative GPA provided on the <u>official transcript</u> will be used to award points based on the following criteria:

- 4.0 or higher
- 3.5 3.99
- 3.0 3.49
- 2.5-2.99

An <u>official transcript</u> that contains the cumulative GPA for courses completed in the Fall 2024 (college applicants) and as of the end of the second grading period (high school applicants) <u>must be</u> submitted with application by April 28, 2025. Note - The <u>final</u> transcript for courses completed in Spring 2025 (college applicants) and as of the end of the fourth grading period (high school applicants) must be submitted by June 15, 2025.

4. Extracurricular Activities

Extracurricular activities include membership in school-sponsored clubs, groups, or events; participation in athletics, part-time jobs, or community service projects, etc. Your participation must be current and verified in writing by the sponsor, employer, or coordinator; and must have occurred during the <u>current academic year</u>. You may submit up to two extracurricular verification forms. (See verification form for completion of this section.)

IV. QUALIFICATION/EVALUATION FOR AWARD

- Applicant must be a full time undergraduate student working toward a degree or professional certification.
- The quantity and amount of awards will be based on the funds available.

V. APPLICATION PROCESS

The financial assistance application process is as follows:

1. Applicants submit all of the following Required Documents by the April 28, 2025 deadline:

- Completed and signed Financial Assistance Application (included in this package)
- Completed Financial Assistance Checklist
- Completed and signed Ministry Involvement Verification Form(s) (included in this package)
- Completed and signed Financial Assistance Notification Form (included in this package)
- Membership Verification Letter from FBCG (recommend you request by April 1, 2025)
- An <u>official transcript</u> that contains your <u>cumulative</u> GPA at the end of the <u>Fall 2024</u> semester/quarter (college students) or as of the second marking period (high school). <u>Please note that an additional final transcript that contains grades for the Spring 2025 semester/quarter must be submitted by June 15, 2025.</u>
- An enrollment verification form from your school's Registrar's Office (college students)
- Your 2025-2026 Student Aid Index (SAI) from FAFSA

Please note: The financial assistance checklist form and notification form must be fully completed and signed by both the student and the parent/guardian.

- 2. The FBCG Financial Assistance Committee notifies applicants that a complete or incomplete application was received. Applicants must acknowledge receipt of the email by replying with the information requested. **Incomplete applications will not receive consideration.**
- 3. FBCG Financial Assistance Committee evaluates applications and recommends award recipients. Final official transcript with the cumulative GPA Grade Reports are due by June 15, 2025. Awards are not confirmed until the final transcript is received.
- 4. Award recipients and non-recipients will be notified by email on or before July 5, 2025.
- 5. Recipients will be recognized during the College Spirit and Recognition Sunday in June or July. Award recipients will be responsible for submitting the information requested that will be featured during one of the FBCG church services.
- 6. Lump-sum award checks are disbursed to each recipient's school by September 8, 2025.

VI. <u>DISQUALIFICATION/FORFEITURE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARD</u>

The following actions will result in the forfeiture/revocation of any financial assistance award:

- Willfully giving false information.
- Failure to submit **ALL** required documentation by the deadline.
- Misuse of funds (Any funds not used for designated purpose MUST be returned to FBCG; funds may be used for the purchase of books if the financial need has been met.)
- Failure to enroll and maintain status as a full-time college student.

VIII. NOTIFICATION

All applicants will be notified via email once the Financial Assistance Committee receives their complete application but no later than May 12, 2025. <u>Applicants are required to acknowledge receipt of the notification email by complying with the instructions listed therein.</u>

IX. AWARD DECISION

On or before **July 5, 2025**, applicants will receive an email that provides their application status (award approved or award denied). The decision of the screening/evaluation committee, in prayerful consultation with the Department Head, CMO, and Pastor is final.
